The Spokane Police Department is hosting the WSPCA 30th Anniversary Spring Seminar. We have some very special events and training planned for this seminar.

Training: **Generalist Patrol Dog** training will include Tactical Tracking, K-9 Defensive Tactics, Post-Pit K-9 deployments, scenario based training and much more. **Narcotics Detection Dog** training will be provided by the [Multijurisdictional Counterdrug Taskforce Training](#). **Explosive Detection Dog** training will be conducted at various unique sites.

Equipment: This is a working seminar. Bring your dog and all your working/training equipment. Because of the special training and some of the locations, all handlers will need to be in regular duty uniform and have ID. Generalist Handlers will need 100 rounds of duty ammunition.
